CSUR OUTREACH Q4 2018 REPORT

Outreach Director Brad Hayes presented lectures based on Outreach materials to fourth-year Petroleum Engineering students at University of Alberta, and to mature students in the Master's in Sustainable Energy Development program at University of Calgary.

CSUR Outreach made a significant step in community engagement with a joint presentation by Brad Hayes, CSUR President Dan Allan and CSUR Chair Wally Kozak to the Synergy Alberta conference in early November. This meeting brings together people from across Alberta, many in rural areas, directly interested in use and preservation of the province's water resources. Dialogues with conference delegates continued after the meeting, and we are currently arranging presentations to the public in Fox Creek in early 2019.

We are engaged in significant upgrades to our Outreach presentation materials, in anticipation of new sessions in Q1 2019. Most significantly, we will be presenting our day-long Unconventionals 101 workshop to AER Hearing Commissioners in early January.
